Also, reported a bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Society of the Redemptorists of the city of Baltimore;

On motion of Mr. Gallagher,

Read the first and by special order the second time, passed, and sent to the senate.

Mr. Buchanan, chairman of the select committee on Retrenchment, to whom was referred the bill entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act relating to the several funds of this State, passed at December session 1838, ch. 390, reported favorably thereon;

Read the first time, and

Ordered to lie upon the table and be printed.

Mr. Simmons reported a bill entitled, an act for the relief of David Trundle of Frederick county;

On motion of Mr. Simmons,

Read the first and by special order the second time, passed, and sent to the senate.

The Speaker laid before the house the reports of the Register of the Land office of the Eastern Shore and of the clerk of Talbot county, shewing amount of money paid into the treasury by them;

Read and referred to the committee on Ways and Means.

And the reports of the clerks of the courts of Talbot and Cecil counties, relating to the attendance of judges;

Read and referred to the committee on Grievances and Courts of Justice.

Mr. Johnson from the committee on Grievances and Courts of Justice, to whom was referred the bill entitled, an act to repeal certain portions of the act passed at December session 1830, ch. 185, entitled, an act to prevent unnecessary expense and delay in prosecuting appeals from courts exercising equity jurisdiction in this State, with the amendments from the senate, reported favorably thereon;

On motion of Mr. Johnson,

Said amendments were read the first, and by special order the second time, and concurred in, and the bill as amended ordered to be engrossed.

On motion of Mr. Staley,

The house adjourned until Monday morning 10 o'clock.
