The question then recurred on the passage of the original bill.

Mr. Buskirk moved the following as a substitute therefor:

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the several incorporated banks of the State of Maryland, be and they are hereby required, on or before the day of in the year of our Lord 1842, and continually thereafter, to pay on demand all their notes, bills, deposites, and other liabilities, (except such as may have been made and created under a special agreement to the contrary,) of the denomination of five dollars and under, in gold and silver coin: and the said banks are hereby required on or before the day of in the year aforesaid, and continually thereafter, to pay on demand, all their notes, bills, deposites and other liabilities, (except such as may have been made and contracted under a special agreement to the contrary,) of the denomination of ten dollars, in gold and silver

coin: and the said banks are hereby required on or before the day of in the year aforesaid, and continually thereafter, to pay on demand, all their notes, bills, deposites, and other liabilities, (except such as may have been made and contracted under special agreement to the contrary,) of every amount and denomination not above mentioned and specified, in gold and silver coin: Provided, that any person or persons may proceed to recover and collect, in gold and silver coin, all debts, liabilities, penalties and damages, due by and recoverable against any of said banks, in the same manner as if this act had not passed.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That if any bank in this State shall, on either of the days mentioned in the preceding section of this act, or at any time thereafter, refuse to pay on demand, any and all its notes, bills, deposites and liabilities, according to the provisions, and with the exceptions, mentioned and set forth in said
