

And the bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Germania Library Association of Baltimore;

Endorsed, will pass with the proposed amendment.

Amendment proposed:

Strike out from the 3rd section the words "estate not exceeding the value of three thousand dollars, and personal estate not exceeding the value of two thousand," and insert in the place of them, "and personal estate not exceeding in the whole five thousand."

Which was read the first and by special order the second time, concurred in, and the bill ordered to be engrossed.

And the bill entitled, an act for the incorporation of Adam Lodge No. 35, of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows;

Endorsed, will pass with the proposed amendment.

Amendment proposed:

In the last line but one of the first section, strike out the word "annual."

Read the first and by special order the second time, concurred in, and the bill ordered to be engrossed.

And the bill entitled, an act directing the levy court and trustees of the alms house of Frederick county, to publish annually a full statement of their receipts and disbursements;

Endorsed, will pass with the proposed amendments.

Amendments proposed:

Add the following section:

And be it enacted, That the Mayor of Frederick shall annually in the month of January, publish in the several newspapers of Frederick, a full and particular statement of all receipts and disbursements, the salaries and per diem of all officers of the corporation, and all extra allowances that may have been allowed to any officer of the corporation, and the services or consideration for such extra allowances.

Amend the title by inserting after the word "county," the words "and Mayor of Frederick."

Read the first and by special order the second time, concurred in, and the bill ordered to be engrossed.

And delivered the bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Chesapeake Steam Saw Mill Company;

Read the first time and referred to the committee on Corporations.

And the bill entitled, an act to unite the trustees of Washington Academy and the Franklin School in Somerset county, into one institution to be called the trustees of Washington Academy;

Read and referred to the committee on Education.

And also, the report of the trustees of Allegany Academy and documents marked A, B and C;

Read and referred to the same committee.
