Mr. Presstman chairman of the committee on Grievances and Courts of Justice, reported a bill entitled, an act to facilitate the execution of commissions issued from other States ;

Read the first time and laid on the table.

Mr. Stone reported a bill entitled, an act authorising the commissioners of Somerset county, to condemn a public landing on St. Peters Creek in Somerset county, at a place called Stump's landing ;
