Read the first and by special order the second time, passed, and sent to the Senate.

Mr. Tuck reported a bill entitled, an act to provide for the more convenient collection of the taxes in Prince George's county, by dividing said county into collection districts ;

Read the first time and laid on the table.

The House then took up the bill entitled, an act concerning the Annapolis and Elk Ridge Rail Road Company, being the order of the day ;

On motion of Mr. Sellman,

The said bill was laid on the table.

The rule being suspended,

On motion of Mr. Starr,

Ordered, That it be noted on the journal that at the time the question was taken on Mr. Presstman's bill, providing for resumption of specie payments by the banks and for other purposes, Mr. Starr was detained from his seat by indisposition, and that he reached his seat soon after the vote was taken, and wished to have his vote recorded in the affirmative, as voting for the bill.

The House then took up the bill entitled, a supplement to an act relating to the importation of passengers, passed December session 1832, ch. 303.

The question being on the passage of the said bill as amended ;

Mr. Presstman then moved the following as a substitute for said bill ;

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That from and after the passage of this act, it shall be the duty of the trustees of the poor of Baltimore city and county, to cause an account to be opened in their books, to be styled the foreigners account, in which the names of all persons shall be entered who may be brought to that institution, who have paid the capitation tax under the provisions of an act passed March 22d, and December session 1832, ch. 303, and that no part of the expense attendant upon their support, shall in any way be charged to Baltimore county.

Which was read.

On the question being put,

Will the House accept the said substitute ?
