

Kemp, and upon the finding of the said jury it appeared that he was acquitted of all charges other than that the said Walter B. Kemp had lost more than \$100 at gaming within three years next before his said application, the said Walter B. Kemp was denied the benefit of the said law. And for the purpose of relieving him from this disability,

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Walter B. Kemp of Frederick county, be and he is hereby entitled to petition for the benefit of the insolvent laws of this State, and that the fact of having been guilty of the violation of the provisions of said laws against gaming, shall not deprive him of relief; provided, no other sufficient allegation shall be proved against him by any of his creditors;

Which was read the first and by special order the second time;

On the question being put,

Will the House accept the said substitute?

It was determined in the affirmative.

The question then recurred on the passage of the said bill;

And on being put,

It was passed and sent to the Senate.

Mr. Ristean from the select committee to which was recommitted the bill entitled, a further supplement to the act entitled, an act to incorporate the Baltimore and Port Deposit Rail Road Company, passed December session 1836, ch. 327, reported the same with the following amendment.

Strike out in the title of said bill "December session 1836," and insert "April the 2nd 1836."

The said bill was then read the second time by special order;

Mr. Presstman then moved to refer the said bill to the committee on Grievances and Courts of Justice;

On the question being put,
