The Speaker laid before the House the following communication :

Annapolis, 7th February, 1842.*

To the Honorable

the House of Delegates :

The Treasurer in obedience to their order of the 1st inst., that he inform them of the "cost of erecting the State's Tobacco Warehouses in the city of Baltimore—what amount of monies have been received from the tobacco inpection revenue—what amount has been appropriated towards the liquidation of the debt for them—and what amount, if any, is now due from the said revenue," submits the accompanying exhibit—shewing the gross revenue from the State's tobacco inspection in Baltimore, to 1st December 1841—the portions thereof disbursed by the inspectors—their payments into the treasury—and the application of these, and of the loans had in aid of the revenue in 1827 and 1837.
