

Mr. Johns, chairman of the committee on Divorces, to which was referred the petitions of Bernard Kelly of Prince George's county, and of Emily Waters of the city of Baltimore, severally praying for acts of divorce, reported unfavorably thereon;

Read the first time and laid on the table.

Mr. Culbreth, from the select committee on that subject, reported a bill entitled, an act to fix the per diem of the members of the Legislature and the several officers thereof of this State;

Read the first time, and

Referred to the committee on Ways and Means.

Mr. Gittings, from the select committee on that subject, reported a bill entitled, an act for closing an old road in Montgomery county, and for declaring another road a public county road;

Read the first and by special order the second time, passed and sent to the Senate.

The rule being suspended,

Mr. Staley presented the petition of one hundred and twenty-three citizens of Frederick county, praying the passage of an act for a speedy resumption of specie payments by the banks of this State;

Read and referred to the consideration of the Senate.

On motion of Mr. Hook,

Leave was granted to Messrs. Hook, Presstman and Risteau to bring in a bill entitled, an act to repeal part of an act entitled, a supplement to authorize the appointment of justices of the peace in the city of Baltimore with limited jurisdiction, passed December session 1834, ch. 289.

On motion of Mr. Gallagher,

The House took up the bill entitled, an act to divorce Mary Nugent of the city of Baltimore from her husband Arthur Nugent;

Read the second time by special order, passed and sent to the Senate.

On motion of Mr. Geyer,

The House took up the bill entitled, an act to provide for taking the vote of the people of this State as to the expediency of calling a convention to reform the present and frame a new constitution, and to amend the constitution, so as to enable the Legislature to call such a convention.

On motion of Mr. Geyer,

Ordered, that the said bill be made the order of the day for Thursday week.

Mr. Dorsey reported a bill entitled, an act to provide for the relief of George Ellicott of Howard District of Anne Arundel county;

Read the first and by special order the second time, passed and sent to the Senate.

On motion of Mr. Graves,

The following resolution was read the first, and by special order the second time, assented to, and sent to the Senate.
