

Amendments proposed:

Strike out in the 11th and 12th lines of the first section the words "at all times hereafter."

Strike out in the 16th line of the first section the word "annual."

Strike out in the 17th line of the first section the word "twenty" and insert "fifty."

Strike out in the 2nd line of the second section the words "forever thereafter."

Insert the following:

"Section 4. And be it enacted, That nothing in this act be construed so as to authorize the said corporation to issue any note, token, device, scrip or other evidence of debt, to be used as currency."

"Section 5. And be it enacted, That this act of incorporation shall enure for thirty years from its passage; and that the Legislature reserves to itself the right to alter or annul this act of incorporation at pleasure."
