the case may be.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That the Baltimore and Ohio Rail Road Company, are hereby prohibited, under the penalties in the preceding section, from issuing any further amount of the orders therein referred to, after the city of Baltimore shall have redeemed any portion of those now in circulation, or after any portion of them are funded, it being the intention of this act, that the said company shall not increase the amount now in circulation, or those which shall remain in circulation, after the city of Baltimore shall have redeemed any portion thereof, or after any of them are funded by the holders thereof, in the stock of the said city.
