

The bill entitled, an act for the relief of Allen Bowie Davis of Montgomery county;

The bill entitled, an act to authorize Richard Gibson, Solomon Krise, Jeremiah Groff, Robert Allison and Joseph Crabbs to sell and convey a certain piece of ground in Frederick county;

The bill entitled, a further supplement to an act entitled, an act to appoint a wreck master in Worcester county;

The bill entitled, an act to grant further time to Thomas Perry of Charles county to complete his collections;

The bill entitled, an act to authorize the commissioners of tax for Carroll county to levy a certain sum of money therein mentioned;

The bill entitled, an act to make valid the title of Ann Bevans of Washington county to certain lands therein mentioned;

The bill entitled, an act supplemental to an act entitled, an act to provide for the appointment of a weigh master of live stock in the city of Baltimore, passed at December session 1837, ch. 313; Severally endorsed "will pass;"

Ordered to be engrossed.

The bill entitled, an act to abolish magistrates' courts in Dorchester county, and to extend the jurisdiction of a single justice of the peace in said county;

Endorsed "will pass with the proposed amendments;"

Amendments proposed:

Strike out the word "March" wherever it occurs and insert "April."

Insert as the third section:

"Section 3. And be it enacted, That a single justice of the peace shall have jurisdiction in all cases of accounts, notes or bonds, when the amount does not exceed the sum of one hundred dollars. In all cases of assault and battery, when the damages laid or claimed do not exceed the sum of fifty dollars, and that in all cases where a warrant is demanded of a justice of the peace in civil cases of assault and battery, he shall require the party demanding the warrant to state the amount of damage claimed, and insert the amount in his warrant."

Read and assented to, and the bill ordered to be engrossed.

The bill entitled, an act authorizing the levy court of Frederick county to levy a sum of money to build a bridge over Catocin creek, near the mill of Israel Ramsburg, on the road leading from Burkettsville to Middletown;

Endorsed "will pass with the proposed amendment."

Amendment proposed:

In the first section strike out the words "two thousand" and insert the words "fifteen hundred;"

Read and assented to, and the bill ordered to be engrossed.

The bill entitled, an act for the benefit of Robert and Cloe Ann Soper of Montgomery county;

Endorsed "will pass with the proposed amendment,"
