And the memorial of sundry citizens of Carroll county, in opposition to the present license law ;

Read and referred to the select committee raised on that subject.

On motion of Mr. Richardson of Baltimore,

Leave was granted to Messrs. Richardson of Baltimore, Presstman, Graves, Starr and Gallagher, to bring in a bill extending the time of John W. Walker, late sheriff of Baltimore county, to complete his collections.

On motion of Mr. Johnson,

The House took up the bill entitled, an act affecting the jurisdiction of the Court of Chancery and the county courts as courts of equity, and the time in which objections to the jurisdiction shall be taken ;

Read the second time by special order, passed and sent to the Senate.

Mr. Spencer then submitted the following order :

Ordered, That the sessions of this House shall hereafter commence at 9 o'clock in the morning, and adjourn at 2 o'clock, and commence again at half past 3 o'clock P. M. and adjourn at 7 o'clock.
