The following amendments were read and assented to:

Strike out in the 4th line of the 3d section the words “appeal tax court” and insert “mayor and city council.”

Add at the end of the 3d section:

“And it is hereby declared to be the duty of the Treasurer of the Western Shore, and he is hereby directed to prepare and furnish to each assessor at the time of his appointment, or as soon thereafter as may be, instructions as regards the manner in which the duties hereby by this act imposed on the said assessor, shall be executed.”
