

The House proceeded with the ordinary business of the session in the absence of the doorkeeper.

Mr. Gallagher reported a bill entitled, an act to provide for the appointment of an additional Inspector of Sole Leather and Rough Harness, and Rough Skirting Leather in the city of Baltimore ;

Read the first time and laid on the table.

Mr. Causin presented the petition of Jesse C. Burroughs, praying to be divorced from his wife Susan C. Burroughs ;

Read and referred to the committee on Divorces.

Mr. Johns, chairman of the committee on Divorces, to which was referred the bill from the Senate entitled, an act to divorce Charlotte Shellman from her husband Jacob Shellman, reported the same with the following amendment ;
