Ordered, That the chief clerk be directed to furnish the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore with three copies of the Journal.

On motion of Mr. Dorsey,

Leave was granted to Messrs. Dorsey, Owens of Anne Arundel, Sellman and Hammond to bring in a bill to repeal an act entitled, an act supplemental to an act entitled, an act to regulate the municipal government of Howard District of Anne Arundel county, passed at December session 1840, ch. 5.

On motion of Mr. Buchanan,

Ordered, That the committee on Ways and Means, hereafter to be appointed, be instructed to inquire into the expediency of laying a tax upon all bills discounted by the several banking and savings' institutions of this State. Also, a tax upon all persons engaged in the business of a broker or dealer in exchanges, such as the buying and selling of gold and silver, or bank notes, or certificates of stocks, circulating as a currency, or any other paper purporting to be a note of a bank, savings' institution, or any other corporation whatever.

On motion of Mr. Graves.

Leave was granted to Messrs. Graves, Tuck, Biser, Gallagher and Gittings to bring in a bill to be entitled, a general act for the incorporation of beneficial and other benevolent associations.
