Insert after the word "confine" in the 15th line of the 4th section the following, "or if no magistrates' courts exist in said district, to any judge of the orphans' court of the same county."

Insert after the word "justice" first occurring in the 17th line the words "or judge of the orphans' court," and insert after the word "justice" last occurring in the same line the words "or judge of the orphans' court."

Mr. Spencer then moved to withdraw the bill from the hands of the chair, to submit a substitute therefor.
