

Ordered, That on to-morrow and every day thereafter, the order of the day be taken up and considered at 10 o'clock A. M.

On motion of Mr. Presstman,

The House took up the bill entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act to incorporate the Atlantic Mutual Insurance Company of Baltimore, passed at December session 1840, ch. 82;

Read the second time by special order, passed and sent to the Senate.

Mr. Buskirk, from the committee on Grievances and Courts of Justice, reported a bill entitled, an act to authorize the division of the real estate of William and Mary Elbert;

Read the first and by special order the second time, passed and sent to the Senate.

On motion of Mr. Newnam,

Leave was granted to Messrs. Newnam, Carmichael and Bryan to bring in a bill for the relief of Edward Powers.

On motion of Mr. Johnson,

The House took up the bill from the Senate entitled, an act for the relief of George H. Stewart, administrator de bonis non of Caleb Batson, late of Calvert county, deceased;

Read the second time.

On motion of Mr. Presstman,

The following amendments were read and assented to:

In the 12th line of the 2nd page of the preamble, after the word "him" insert the words "as executor of William Stewart, the sum."

In the 14th line on the same page strike out the words "administrator de bonis non" and insert the words "executor of William Stewart."

In the 4th line of the 1st section of the bill, after the words "Thomas Batson" insert the words "Galen Batson."

At the end of the bill add:

"After applying the said estate so far as may be necessary to satisfy any balance due to said administrator de bonis non."

The question then recurred on the passage of the bill as amended;

And on being put,

It was passed and returned to the Senate.

On motion of Mr. Maccubbin,

The House took up the bill entitled, an act for the benefit of the administrator of Thomas H. Edelin, late sheriff of Prince George's county, deceased;

Read the second time, passed and sent to the Senate.
