

Which was read and concurred in.

The House then took up the bill entitled, an act to authorize the licensing of stock brokers, exchange brokers and bill brokers, and to regulate contracts for the purchase and sale of loans and stocks;

The question being on the motion of Mr. Carmichael to fill up the blank in the 4th line of the 1st section with the word "ten," as a substitute for the motion of Mr. Tuck to fill up the said blank with word "three;"

When Mr. Carmichael withdrew his motion.

The question then recurred on assenting to the amendment submitted by Mr. Tuck;

And on being put, it was assented to.

On motion of Mr. Carmichael,

The vote on filling up the said blank with the word "three," was reconsidered.

On motion of Mr. Carmichael,

The said blank was filled up with the word "one."

On motion of Mr. Tuck,

The following amendments were read and assented to:

Insert in the blank in the 3rd line of the 2nd section the word "three."

Insert after the word "exchange" in the 11th line of said section the words "bank notes."

Insert in the blank in the 3rd line of the 3rd section the word "three."

On motion of Mr. Carmichael,

The following amendment was read and assented to:

Add at the end of the 3rd section the following:

"Provided, That every person who shall deal in any manner directly or indirectly in the purchase of stocks, bills, notes and other obligations, shall be deemed and taken to be a broker in the meaning of the first, second and third sections of this act; and provided further, that no such person shall be obliged to pay a license for the clerks or agents employed by him."

On motion of Mr. Tuck,

The following amendments were read and assented to:

Insert in the blank in the 19th line of the 7th section the word "three."

And insert in the blank in the 25th line of the same section the word "one."

The question then recurred on the passage of the said bill;

And on being put,

It was passed and sent to the Senate.

The clerk of the Senate delivered a petition of Jacob Kirk and others, for the alteration of the tax law;

Read and referred to the committee on Ways and Means.
