The bill entitled, an act to authorise the division of the real estate of William and Mary Elbert ;

The bill entitled, an act to authorise Joseph M. Fowler, to invest the estate of his ward Joseph S. Fowler, under the direction of the Orphans court of Prince George's county ;

The bill entitled, an act for the relief of Mary Caples, widow of Jacob Caples, deceased, late collector of taxes, in the seventh collection district of Baltimore county ;

The bill entitled, an act to facilitate the collection of a portion of the tax levied in pursuance of the act of Assembly, passed March session 1841, ch. 23 ;

The bill entitled, an act to authorise the licensing of stock brokers, exchange brokers and bill brokers, and to regulate contracts for the purchase and sale of loans and stocks ;

The bill entitled, an act to regulate the fees of Notaries Public ;
