Mr. Poultney presented the petition of John L. Hammond, guardian of Thomasina H. Gist, praying that a law may be passed, authorising a lease of said minor's real estate;

Read and referred to the committee on Grievances and Courts of Justice.

Mr. Johns presented the petition of Eliza Fergusin of Harford county, praying to be placed upon the pension list of said county;

Read and referred to the committee on Pensions to Indigent Persons by County Assessment.

Mr. Buchanan presented the petition of sundry citizens of Cumberland, Flinstone, Westernport and Glades election districts, in Allegany county, praying that the land now obtained by the academy in the town of Cumberland from the State be transferred from said academy to the common school fund of Allegany county;

Read and referred to Messrs. Buchanan, Shaw and Buskirk.

Also, the petition of Edward Johnson of Allegany county, praying a return of \$206.28 cts. paid by him improperly into the Land Office of the Western Shore;

Which was read, and on motion of Mr. Causin,

Referred to the committee on Grievances and Courts of Justice.

Also, three several petitions of one hundred and sixty-five citizens of Maryland, Virginia and Pennsylvania, praying for relief as creditors of the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal Company, and of the construction thereof;

Read and referred to the committee on Internal Improvements.
