The committee on the Library, to which was referred the communication of D. McCurdy in relation to his new system for teaching Geometry, submit and recommend the adoption of the following resolutions:

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Librarian be and he is hereby authorized and directed to purchase nine hundred copies of an essay "on the means and importance of introducing the natural sciences, and diffusing the elements of Geometry into the plan of popular education;" and the Treasurer of the Western Shore is hereby directed to pay for the same out of any unappropriated money in the Treasury, provided the cost shall not exceed seventy dollars.

Resolved, That the said copies shall be distributed among the several counties of the State, under the direction of the joint committee on the Library, for the use of the public schools.
