Read and referred to the committee on Ways and Means.

And returned the resolution relating to the payment of the members and officers of the Legislature;

Endorsed "assented to;" Ordered to be engrossed.

On motion of Mr. Buchanan,

The House took up for consideration the reports of the majority and minority of the select committee on Printing.

On motion of Mr. Causin,

The House was called and the doorkeeper sent after the absent members.

On motion of Mr. Geyer,

The House proceeded with the ordinary business of the session in the absence of the doorkeeper.

Mr. Starr, from the select committee on that subject, reported a bill entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act to establish State warehouses for the inspection of tobacco in the city of Baltimore, passed December session, 1822, ch. 165;

Read the first time and referred to the committee on Inspections.

Mr. Nicols of Dorchester reported a bill to make valid an indenture of apprenticeship, in favor of Samuel Sewell of Dorchester county;

Read the first time and laid on the table.

Mr. Forwood reported a bill entitled, an act regulating the compensation of the county surveyor, and prescribing certain duties therein named, so far as the same relates to Cecil county;

Read the first time and referred to the committee on Grievances and Courts of Justice.

Mr. Staley reported a bill entitled, an act to authorise the sale of a school house in school district No. 26, in Frederick county;

Read the first and by special order the second time and will pass.

The Speaker laid before the House a report of the Register in Chancery, showing the amount of taxes on bills and so forth, paid into the Treasury;

Read and referred to the committee on Grievances and Courts of Justice.
