Amendments proposed :

Strike out "two" and insert "one," last line but one of the bill.

Add at the end of the section :

"To settle such claims as may have been preferred within the terms and provisions of the original act to which this is a supplement."

Read and assented to.

And the bill entitled, an act for the relief of sundry poor persons in the several counties therein mentioned;

Endorsed "will pass with the proposed amendments;"

Amendments proposed :

After the word "Woodall" in the 17th line insert "for the support of his idiot son;"

After the figure "30" in the last line insert "in addition to the sum heretofore allowed him;"

Read and assented to.

Mr. Pressman, chairman of the committee on Grievances and Courts of Justice, to which was referred the bill from the Senate entitled, an act relating to the Court of Chancery, reported the same without amendment;

Read the second time by special order, passed and returned to the Senate.

Mr. Tuck, from the committee on Grievances and Courts of Justice, to which was referred the bill from the Senate entitled, an act to make valid a certain instrument of writing therein mentioned, reported the same without amendment;

Read the second time by special order, passed and returned to the Senate.

The doorkeeper returned and reported that he had notified the absent members that their attendance was required in the House.

The question then recurred on assenting to the amendments proposed by the Senate to the bill entitled, an act to complete the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal to Cumberland.

On motion of Mr. Buskirk,

The question was taken seriatim on the said amendments;

And on being put,

On the first amendment it was assented to.

The question then recurred on assenting to the next amendment;

Mr. Nicols of Caroline moved to reject the said amendment;

On the question being put,

It was determined in the affirmative.
