

BALTIMORE AND OHIO RAIL ROAD—

Petition of citizens of Anne Arundel county for a tax on all bank notes, &c. except the stock orders of the, presented and referred 356.

Order adopted directing the president of the, to furnish a full account of the official proceedings with reference to the issue of stock orders of the said company, &c. 513.

Bill reported for the further regulation of transportation upon the, read a first and second time and rejected 534-5.
