

GOVERNOR—

Order that the, furnish the house with the accounts of Jeremiah Hughes, for printing the journal and documents of last session and with any other papers, &c. showing if contract as public printer for the last year was complied with 23; order complied with 38.

That portion of the message of the, relating to the Tariff, referred to a select committee 24.

So much of the, message as relates to the subject of banks and the currency, referred to the committee already raised on that subject 25.

Honorable Francis Thomas qualifies as, of the State of Maryland 51.

So much of the, messages as relate to the resolution of December session 1835, having reference to Capt. J. A. Webster, referred to a select committee 60; committee named *ib*; same committee ordered to inquire into the conduct of Senators Kerr and Merrick *ib*.

Order requesting the, to cause the national flag to be displayed from the State house steeple on the 8th January, in commemoration of the victory at New Orleans in 1815, submitted and read 72; amendment proposed and rejected and original order adopted 73.

Ordered that the, communicate the last annual report of the Adjutant General 103; report made 120, 121, 122.

Ordered, that the, state the amount expended by virtue of resolution No. 30 of December session 1832, with the items of charge, the names of persons paid, and with whom the contract, if any, was made in pursuance of that resolution 187.

Message adopted inviting the, to attend in the senate chamber to sign such laws as may have been engrossed, sent to the senate 287; message received concurring 311.

The Speaker and members of the house attended in the senate chamber to witness the, sign the engrossed bills from No. 1 to 76, 337.

Resolution directing the, to make such compensation to I. N. Steele as he may think proper, for professional services rendered the State, read, assented to and sent to the senate 443; returned assented to 480.

Order adopted requiring the president and directors of the Tide Water canal company to report to the, the condition of their affairs, &c. 447.

Resolution authorizing the, to obtain copies of the several opinions delivered by the judges of the Supreme Court of the United States in the case of *Prigg vs. the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania*, and to have the same printed and distributed as therein directed, read, assent-
