The house took up for consideration the bill, entitled an act to repeal certain portions of the act passed at December session, 1830, ch. 185, entitled an act to prevent unnecessary expense and delay in prosecuting appeals from courts exercising equity jurisdiction in this State;

Read the second time, passed and sent to the senate.

On motion of Mr. Buskirk,

The house took up the bill entitled, an act to suspend the running of the act of limitations in certain cases;

Read the second time, and

On motion of Mr. Carmichael, ordered to lie on the table.

The clerk of the senate delivered a bill entitled, an act authorising Edward McCarty and James McCarty, of Allegany county, to erect gates on certain public roads passing through their lands in said county;

Read and referred to Messrs. Shaw, Buchanan and Buskirk.

Also, a bill entitled, an act for the relief of Frisby Tilgham, of Washington county;

Read and referred to Messrs. Spencer, Hollman, Grove and Lyday.

Also, a bill entitled, an act to give to the Chancellor and the county courts as courts of equity, jurisdiction in cases of divorce.
