

LIBRARY, STATE—Resolution giving David Ridgely of the city of Annapolis, free access and use of the, read, assented to and sent to the senate 482; returned assented to 579.

Resolution from the senate giving to the State Printers the use of the, read and referred to the committee on, 504.

LICENSE—Committee on ways and means instructed to inquire into the propriety of increasing the price now paid for, to auctioneers, brokers, lottery dealers, hawkers and pedlars, &c. also the imposing a tax or, on commission merchants 52.

Petition of twenty-three citizens of Maryland for a law prohibiting any, to be issued for retailing intoxicating drinks, to be decided by the ballot box, &c. presented and referred 144.

Leave to bring in a supplementary bill to the act, and regulating ordinary keepers 136; bill reported and ordered to be printed 146; taken up, passed and sent to the senate 285; returned rejected 323.

Two petitions of sundry citizens of Washington county, for a law prohibiting any, to be issued for retailing intoxicating drinks throughout the State and prohibiting the sale on the Lord's day, presented and referred 151.

Order to inquire into the propriety of imposing a tax or, upon all brokers, stock jobbers, &c. adopted 193.

Bill reported to, theatrical and other public exhibitions, &c. read and ordered to be printed 324; taken up, amended, passed and sent to the senate 424; returned passed 486.

Bill reported supplementary to the act regulating the, of hawkers and pedlars, read and laid on the table 400; read a second time and laid on the table 408; taken up 569; amended, passed and sent to the senate 570; returned rejected 585.

Bill reported to, brokers, exchange brokers and bill brokers, and to regulate contracts for the purchase and sale of loans and stocks, read and ordered to be printed 421; amendments submitted 506; amendments withdrawn 516; sundry amendments adopted *ib*; bill as amended passed and sent to the senate *ib*; returned passed *ib*.
