

**MAGISTRATES COURTS**—Leave for a bill to abolish the, in St. Mary's county, and to extend the jurisdiction of a single justice of the peace 29; bill reported, passed and sent to the senate 212; returned passed 271.

Leave for a bill requiring the judges of county courts to set apart a particular day of each term for the hearing of appeals from, 35; bill reported and referred 78; favorable report, read and laid on the table 329.

Leave for a bill to repeal so much of the act of 1835, as allows a per diem to the justices of the, so far as relates to Carroll county 59.

Petition of Townly B. Robey and others, for the establishment of, in Prince George's county, presented and referred 94; bill reported and laid on the table 352; taken up, passed and sent to the senate 392; returned passed 486.

Bill to repeal a supplemental act of 1839, ch. 11, establishing, in the several counties in this State, and prescribing their jurisdiction, reported, passed and sent to the senate 116; returned rejected 162.

Leave for a bill giving jurisdiction to Somerset county courts concurrent with the, of said county 123; bill reported, passed and sent to the senate 130; returned passed 162.

Leave for a bill to repeal, in Kent county, and extend the jurisdiction of single magistrates 123; bill reported 144; passed and sent to the senate 164; returned passed 217.

Petition of sundry citizens of Prince George's county, for a law to re-establish, in said county, presented and referred 144.

Petition of citizens of the third election district of Prince George's county that, may not be re-established in said county, presented and referred 173.

Leave for a supplement to the act establishing, in the several counties of this State, and to prescribe their jurisdiction 203; bill reported and laid on the table 212; passed and sent to the senate 226; returned rejected 312; message to the senate returning the bill and asking a reconsideration 443; bill returned with amendments which are laid on the table 505; message from the senate asking the return of the bill 557; returned with an amendment which is assented to 564-5.
