

Add the following section:

Sec. 6. And be it enacted, That nothing in this act shall be so construed as to authorise the said corporation to issue any note, scrip, token, device, or other evidence of debt, to be used as currency.

Which were read and concurred in, and the bill as amended, read the second time by special order and passed.

Also, from the same committee to whom had been recommitted the bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Mount Clare Total Abstinence Society of Baltimore, reported again the same with the following corrected amendments,

Strike out the word "in" in the fourth line of the preamble, and insert the word "and;"

Strike out the word "forever" in the fifth line of the first section;

Strike out the words "ten thousand" in the twelfth line of the first section and insert the words "five thousand";

Strike out the word "forever" in the second line of the second section;

Which were read and concurred in, and the bill as amended read a second time by special order and passed.
