

## SLAVEHOLDERS CONVENTION—

Similar petition from members of the same church in Worcester county, presented and referred 346.

Similar petition from William Brewer and others, of Annapolis, presented and referred 356.

Several memorials against the provisions of the late, presented and referred 395.

Order adopted referring the various petitions and memorials relating to the, to the consideration of the senate 450.

Petition of citizens of St. Mary's county, members of the Methodist Episcopal church, counter to certain propositions of the late, presented and referred to the senate 507.

Petition of citizens of Talbot county, protesting against certain proceedings of the late, presented and referred to the senate 512.

Petitions of citizens of Baltimore county remonstrating against the passage of a law in reference to the colored population, presented and referred to the senate 512.

**SLAVES**—Leave to bring in a bill for the better regulation of the colored population of this State, and for the security of negro, &c. 23; bill reported and ordered to be printed 241; taken up and amended 335; amendment submitted 336; assented to 340; various amendments submitted and adopted 341-2-3; various amendments proposed, adopted and rejected 352-3-4-5-6; further amended and bill as amended, ordered to be printed 366-7; taken up, and several amendments adopted and rejected 410-11; motion to reject the bill, negatived and vote thereon 412; further amended 413; bill as amended, passed and vote thereon 414; sent to the senate 436; returned rejected 538.

Leave granted to committee on colored population for a bill to authorize Mrs. Mary Wilmer to bring certain, therein mentioned into this State 53.

Leave granted for a bill supplementary to the act of 1834, ch. 323, relating to free negroes, &c. 68.

Order raising a select committee to inquire whether the valuation of, under the late assessment law is uniform throughout the State 81; report submitted and ordered to be printed 221. See Doc. F.

Petition of Edward Plater, for indemnity for the loss of a negro, presented and referred 134; reported, passed and sent to the senate 466; returned passed 504.
