

STATE'S AGENTS—Message adopted informing the senate, that the house declines concurring in the senate's resolution to appoint, in joint stock companies, and proposing a committee of conference 494; message from the senate concurring in the appointment of said committee 504; report of the committee on the part of the house 510.

Order submitted to instruct the joint committee on the part of the house to propose the names of William Grason and William Matthews to the committee, &c. as, 510; order rejected and vote thereon 511.

STATE ARMORY AND TOWN HALL COMMISSIONERS—Order adopted requiring the, to produce their account and vouchers upon oath to the Treasurer, to be by him audited, and the results reported to the next General Assembly 533.

STATE BONDS—Order that the president of the Baltimore and Ohio rail road company, report what amount of, have been sold or hypothecated in the year 1841, to whom sold, at what price, &c. submitted and amended and adopted 20-1; reconsidered 32; amendment proposed and adopted 33.

Order that the committee on resumption of specie payments inquire and report whether the Baltimore and Ohio rail road company, may not be required to apply the proceeds of the, in possession of said company to the purchase of the stock orders of said company, and if such application would not be greatly to the interest of the community, amended and adopted 34.

Order that the president of the Chesapeake and Ohio canal company report what amount of, have been sold or hypothecated by said company in the year 1841, to whom sold or hypothecated and at what prices, the disposition made of, authorised to be issued by act of December session 1840, ch. 30, and what amount of, the company hold that are not hypothecated 36.
