Resolution directing the, to pay Francis Valdenar, executor of William Layman, a revolutionary pensioner of Maryland, the amount of pension due him at the time of his death, assented to and sent to the senate 435; returned assented to 461.

Resolution directing the, to pay Samuel D. Sutton a sum of money for the use of Edward Paul Plowden, &c. read and referred 446.

Resolution directing the, to pay to the order of the chief clerk of each house respectively the accounts presented for newspapers furnished members, &c. proposed, assented to and sent to the senate 495; returned assented to 517.
