Resolution directing the, to pay the printers of the house for such reports, &c. on hand at the time of adjournment and forward the same to the members of the legislature, read, assented to and sent to the senate 569; returned passed 584.

Resolution directing the, to dispose of so much of the bank stock belonging to the State, as will meet the temporary loans of the past year, submitted 571; passed, sent to the senate and vote thereon 572; returned dissented from 585; message to the senate returning the resolution and asking a reconsideration 591-2; message in reply dissenting from the house 595-6.

Resolution directing the, to pay the chief, assistant and committee clerks of the two houses, the several sums therein contained, submitted 577; read a first and second time and rejected 578; resolution reconsidered 583-4; passed and sent to the senate 584; returned assented to 590.

Resolution directing the, to pay Asaph Colegate, a soldier of the revolution, the half pay of a private from and after this date, reported, passed and sent to the senate 567; returned passed 579.

Resolution to pay William Glover twenty-four dollars for services rendered in the senate chamber during the present session, read, assented to and sent to the senate 583; returned assented to 590.
