Leave was granted to Messrs. Buskirk, Shaw and Buchanan, to bring in a bill to repeal an act passed at December session 1840, ch. 238.

Mr. Forwood asked the following leave:

Leave to bring in a bill to pass all the property belonging to the government of the State, except the State House, and such as may be necessary to bear the ordinary expenses of government, into the hands of trustees for the benefit of the creditors of the State;

Mr. Causin moved to reject the said leave;
