Mr. Levering submitted the following preamble and resolutions:

Whereas, the United States being the natural as well as legal guardian of the Indian tribes within the limits of the Union, and their having by the agency of laws caused the removal of the great body of those Indian tribes from within the jurisdictional limits of nearly all the States and Territories, from the east to the west of the Mississippi, and beyond the south western confines of the States of Arkansas and Missouri, where they are now in great numbers embodied; and whereas, the tenure by which those tribes hold their title to the lands which have been assigned them there, being no more durable than were those by which they held lands when occupants of territory on the east of the Mississippi, thereby rendering them liable to a continuation of the same policy that has obtained in all the past, of getting from them their lands and urging them still further west, thereby interrupting and breaking up systems which the humane, the just and the merciful, as well
