Which were severally read the first, and by a special order the

second time, severally passed and sent to the Senate.

Mr. Yellott from the committee on Ways and Means, reported a bill entitled, an act to provide for the registry of free negroes and mulattoes.

Which was read, and

On motion of Mr. Yellott,

Ordered to be printed.

Mr. Ecker reported a bill entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act to establish magistrates courts in the several counties, and to prescribe their jurisdiction;

Which was read and referred to the committee on Grievances

and Courts of Justice.

Mr. Chapman chairman of the committee on Corporations, to which was referred the bill from the Senate entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act to incorporate the New Middleburg School, reported the same without amendment;

Which was read the first time, and ordered to lie on the table. Mr. Chapman chairman of the committee on Corporations, made unfavorable reports upon the following petitions, viz:

The petition of the board of directors of the Frederick Town

Savings Institution; and,

Four memorials signed by H. R. Smeltzer, S. G. Harbaugh, Jacob Bear, and many other citizens of Frederick county, praying that the Frederick Town Savings Institution, be allowed to issue notes of a denomination of not less than one dollar, and not to exceed in amount twenty-five thousand dollars;

Which reports were severally read the first, and by a special

order the second time and concurred in.

Mr. Poultney presented the memorial of thirty-seven citizens of Baltimore county, praying that the petition of the Baltimore and Harford turnpike company, may be granted, and in opposition to the memorials from Harford; and,

Mr. Welsh presented the memorials of sundry citizens of Baltimo: e county in favor of the Baltimore and Harford turnpike company, and in opposition to the memorial from Harford county;

Which were severally read and referred to the committee al-

ready appointed on that subject.

The clerk of the Senate returned the bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Harsinai Verein Society of the city of Baltimore;

Also, the bill entitled, an act to authorise the commissioners of Harford county, to build a bridge over Winter Run at Davis'

Ford, in said county;

Also, the bill entitled, an act for the incorporation of the Evening Star Encampment of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows of the State of Maryland, located in the Town of Havre de

Also, the bill entitled, an act repealing the act of eighteen hundred, chapter twenty-one, passed for the preservation of the breed of fish in the great Choptank river;
