

TUESDAY, February 13th, 1844.

The Speaker announced the following message as having been received from the Senate on yesterday :

The bill entitled, an act to provide for the appointment of wood corder in the town of St. Michael's, in Talbot county ;

Also, the bill entitled, an act for the relief of James M. Smith, the executor of Philip Smith, and for other purposes ;

Severally endorsed, "will pass," and the bills ordered to be engrossed.

Also, the bill entitled, an act to allow William Frush, late collector of tax in Baltimore county, further time to complete his collections ;

Also, the bill entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act to incorporate the Roman Catholic Congregation Worshipping at Christ's Roman Catholic Church near Westminster in Frederick county, passed at Dec. session 1829, ch. 174, and also,

To confirm and make good and valid a devise contained in he last will and testament of Frances Conley, late of Carroll county, deceased ;

Endorsed "will pass with the proposed amendments."

Which amendments were twice read, assented to, and the bill ordered to be engrossed.

Also, the resolutions relative to the sale of the coupons and interest on the stock of the State standing to the credit of the sinking fund ;

Endorsed, "assented to," and the resolutions ordered to be engrossed.

And delivered a bill originated in and passed by the Senate, entitled, an act to cure a defective deed from Thomas Bittles and Mary Bittles, and others, to Adam Miller, of Frederick county ;

Which was read and referred to Messrs Ecker, Shaw and Powder.
