Pigman, Esq., Deputy Attorney General of Allegany county, a reasonable compensation for the services, which he lately rendered to the State, in the trial of a cause in the Court of Appeals, in which the interests of the State were deeply involved, and questions of vital consequence to Maryland were settled;
