The House then resumed the consideration of the order of the day, being the bill reported by Mr. Johnson, chairman, of the committee on Ways and Means, entitled, a further supplement to the act entitled, an act for the general valuation and assessment of property in this State, passed at March session 1841, chapter 23.

Said bill was amended by adding at the end of the sixth section the following proviso, "and provided further, that upon the payment of the taxes so due as aforesaid, the title shall pass, notwithstanding the provisions of this act."

Mr. Waters, of Somerset, moved to amend said bill by striking out in the sixth section, fifth line from the word "indebted," to the end of said section;
