

The bill entitled, an act to authorise the commissioners of Harford county, to levy a sum of money for the benefit of Mary Waters, of said county ;

Were sent to the Senate.

Mr. Temples presented the petition of John Coppage, and others, praying for a renewal of a law passed at December session 1834, ch. 264, for the purpose of draining the right prong of a branch in Queen Anne' county, known by the name of the Andover branch ;

Which was read and referred to Messrs. Temples, Harrison and Earickson.

Mr. Naill presented ths memorial of sundry citizens of New Market, in Frederick county, remonstrating against the repeal of the magistrates court law in said county ;

Which was read and referred to Messrs. Naill, Thomas, of Frederick, Shriver, Buckey and Lynch.

Mr. Warfield presented the petition of Rebecca H. Shipley, of Howard District, in Anne Arundel county, praying for the passage of a law to enable her to hold and dispose of certain property therein mentioned ;

Which was read and referred to Messrs. Warfield, Johnson Ligon, Thomas, of Anne Arundel and Murray.

Mr. Spencer presented the petition of sundry citizens of Kent county, praying the passage of a law to protect wild fowl in the head waters of the Chesapeake bay, and its tributaries.

Which was read and referred to the joint delegations of Kent, Harford, Cecil and Baltimore counties.

Mr. Lackland presented the petition of forty-seven citizens of Cecil county, praying the passage of an act preventing obstructions to fishing in the head waters of the Chesapeake bay ;

Which was read and referred to the committee on Grievances and Courts of Justice.

Mr. Stepenson presented the memorial of fifty citizens of Harford county, praying that mackerel may not be exempt from inspection ;

Which was read and referred to the committee on Inspections.

On motion of Mr. Buckey,

Ordered, That the committee on Ways and Means, inquire into the expediency of increasing the tax upon hawkers and pedlars.

On motion of Mr. Ghiselin,

Leave was granted Messrs. Ghiselin, Semmes, Calvert and Wootten, to bring in a bill to allow Thomas M. D. Baden, former collector of Prince George's county, further time to complete his collections.

On motion of Mr. Yellott,

Ordered, That he have leave to withdraw from the files of the House, the petition of Michael Whiteford, of Harford county, praying for a pension.
