

Ordered, That John M. McCalla, agent for Henry King's heirs, have leave to withdraw from the files of the House, the petition of and accompanying papers of Henry King, late of the State of Kentucky, presented at the session of 1817, praying for a pension for Revolutionary services.

Mr. Semmes from the committee on Ways and Means, submitted the following resolutions :

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer, be and he is hereby authorised and directed to sell and dispose of all the bank stock owned by the State at public auction, at such time or times and place or places, and in such parcel or parcels, as he may deem best, to be paid for in cash, State bonds, certificates of debt due by the State, or interest due and payable thereon; provided, that no part of such bank stock shall be sold for less than its par value.

Resolved, That when the Treasurer shall have sold and disposed of the bank stock owned by the State or any part thereof under the provisions of the above resolution, he shall transfer to the purchaser or purchasers in the name of the State of Maryland a full and perfect title to all such bank stock so sold and disposed of.

Which was read the first time, and ordered to lie on the table.

Mr. Ecker submitted the following resolution :

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the State Librarian, be and he is hereby authorised and required to furnish to the Treasurer of the New Windsor Library Company, one copy of Dorsey's Laws of Maryland.

Which was read the first, and by a special order the second time, assented to, and sent to the Senate.

Mr. Kilgour reported a bill entitled, an act to authorise Samuel C. Viers, trustee of William O'Neale, jr. late sheriff and collector of Montgomery county, further time to complete his collections ;

Which was read the first and by special order the second time, passed and sent to the Senate.

Mr. Ligon reported a bill entitled, an act authorising the commissioners of tax of Howard District, of Anne Arundel county, to provide for the payment of debts due to mechanics and others, contracted on account of public buildings in said district ;

Which was read the first and second time by a special order ;

Mr. Warfield offered as a substitute for said bill, "A bill entitled, an act for the relief of certain mechanics and others, of Howard District, of Anne Arundel county ;"

Which was read,

Mr. Warfield moved to lay said bill and substitute on the table until to-morrow ;

Resolved in the affirmative.

Mr. McKaig reported a bill entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act to incorporate the town of Frostburg, in Allegany county ;
