The House took up for consideration the bill reported by him as chairman of the committee on Ways and Means, entitled, an additional supplement to an act entitled, an act to regulate sales by public auction, passed at December session 1827, chapter 111;

The said bill was then read the second time and passed.

Mr. Waters of Somerset, reported a bill entitled, an act to change the name of John Woodland Crisfield, infant son of John W. Crisfield of Somerset county, to Henry Page;

Which was read the first, and by a special order the second

time, and passed.

The clerk of the Senate returned the bill entitled, an act to authorise the trustees of school district No. 2, in election district No. 1, of Talbot county, to levy a tax for the payment of rent due for school houses in said district;

Also, the bill entitled, an act to incorporate the trustees of the Deer Creek Harmony Church in Harford county;

Also, the bill entitled, an act for the preservation of fish in the waters of Talbot, Dorchester and Caroline counties;

Also, the bill entitled, an act for the relief of Joseph Richardson clerk of Caroline county court, and for the benefit of all persons concerned in the records of said court, which may have been lost or stolen from the office of said clerk;

Also, the bill entitled, an act to change the name of the village in Cecil county, known by the name of Harris' Cross Roads to that of Harrisville;

Also, the bill entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act to establish magistrates courts in the several counties of this State and to prescribe their jurisdiction;

Also, the bill entitled, an act to incorporate the trustees of the

Methodist Episcopal Church of New Windsor;

Also, the bill entitled, a supplement to the act entitled, an act to incorporate the town of Frostburg in Allegany county;

And, the bill entitled, an act for the benefit of the fishery known by the name of Edmandson's Island, (or Shad Battery;)

Severally endorsed, "will pass," and the bills ordered to be engrossed.

Also, the bill entitled, an act to regulate the terms of Prince George's county court;

"Endorsed will pass with the proposed amendments:"

Which amendments were twice read, assented to, and the bill ordered to be engrossed.

Also, the bill entitled, an act to regulate the height of fences in election district No. 5, in Allegany county, and for other purposes; Endorsed, "the first amendment receded from," and the bill

ordered to be engrossed.

Also, the resolution in favor of Hanson B. Pigman;

Endorsed, assented to, and the resolution ordered to be engrossed.
