Petition of J. S. Crockett, of Somerset county, for further time to complete his, referred 368; bill reported, passed and sent to the senate 374; returned passed and ordered to be engrossed 410.

Leave granted to report a bill to allow B. T. Pindle, of Anne Arundel county, further time to complete his, 374; bill reported. passed and sent to the senate 386; returned passed and ordered to be engrossed 421.
