Leave granted to report a bill to alter and change the, so as to reduce the term of State senators to three years, and to elect one third of the senators annually, referred 293; unfavorable report concurred in 358.

The committee on retrenchment instructed to inquire into the expediency of altering the, so as to graduate the representation in the House of Delegates on a basis, detailed, and so as to admit Howard District to the rank of a county 320.

Leave granted to report a bill to alter the, so as to prevent the necessity of a second election in case of a tie 276; bill reported and ordered to be printed 339; taken up, and the enacting clause stricken out 476.

Bill reported to amend the, 520; passed and sent to the senate, *ib*; returned rejected 534.
