ATURE - Leave for a bill to alter and amend the Constitution, so as to establish biennial, instead of annual sessions of the, 9; bill reported 23; made the order of Monday 8th January 30; motion to strike out the enacting clause 70; prevails by 36 years to 35 nays 78; vote reconsidered, and the bill recommitted 83; again reported and ordered to be printed 131; considered 392; passed 393; and sent to the senate 394; returned rejected 503.
