LICENSE—Petition of grand jury of St Mary's county for a modi-fication of the law relative to, for the sale of spiritous liquors 7.

Petition of citizens of Calvert county for a law pro-hibiting any, to be issued for retailing spiritous liquors in this State, referred 146.

Petition of citizens of the Swamp Total Abstinence society of Anne Arundel county, praying some altera-tion in the, system, referred 211.

Petition of 1262 citizens of Baltimore for a law to prohibit any, to be issued for retailing intoxicating drinks in any election district wherein a majority of voters may by ballot desire to prohibit the same, referred 304.

Petition of citizens of Frederick county for an altera-tion of the, law, in regard to hawkers and pedlars, re-ferred 221; unfavorable report concurred in 380.

Petition of citizens of Cumberland for an auction, law, referred 226.

Petition of citizens of Harford county, for a repeal of the present, law, so far as relates to taverns, grog shops, and other places where intoxicating liquors are sold, referred 304.

Petition of citizens of Talbot, for a law in relation to, for the sale of ardent spirits, upon the terms therein mentioned, referred 345.

Bill to, woodhucksters in Baltimore city, and to repeal the act therein named, reported, passed, and sent to the senate 399; returned passed with amendments which are assented to and the bill ordered to be engrossed 431.
