Petition of citizens of Allegany county, for a law to give jurisdiction to, in cases of attachments in small sums 114; bill reported, substitute proposed and adopted 149; passed and sent to the senate *ib*; returned passed with amendments, which are assented to, and the bill ordered to be engrossed 176.

Leave for a bill to authorize commissions to issue, to take testimony in all cases of appeals from the decisions of single, and the district courts of Charles county, referred 21; bill reported 38; passed and sent to the senate 39; returned rejected 432.
