

MARYLAND STEAMBOAT COMPANY—Leave granted to report a bill supplemental to the act incorporating the, 462; bill reported, passed and sent to the senate 466; returned, passed and ordered to be engrossed 484.

MASSACHUSETTS—Communication from the governor, transmitting resolutions of the legislature of the state of, respecting the annexation of Texas to the United States, received and ordered to lie on the table 40; referred to the committee on printing, with instructions to have such as they deemed expedient, printed 43; committee report that the first be printed and the latter referred to the committee on coloured population, concurred in 73; the committee report that they differ from the views expressed in the resolution and asked to be discharged from its further consideration, which is concurred in 102.
