Bill from the committee on retrenchment, to reduce one-fourth the, of all officers paid out of State Treasury, except those fixed by the constitution, ordered to be printed 67; made the order of 30th January, 144; taken up, and amendments proposed 467; adopted 470; further considered, *ib*; the bill passed 471; and sent to the senate 472; returned rejected 521.

Noted, that had Mr. Reeder, been present, he would have voted, against said bill 474.
