Petition of Washington Goldsborough, to have certain negroes brought from Delaware into this State, referred 319; unfavorable report, concurred in 349.

Petition of Robert Taylor, to be allowed to bring into this State, a, referred 329; unfavorable report, concurred in 349.

Leave granted to report a bill to allow Jesse Selby, of Prince George's county, to hold and retain a, in this State 330; bill reported, passed and sent to the senate 341; returned passed with amendments, which are assented to and the bill ordered to be engrossed 356.

Leave granted to report a bill to authorise David Trundle, to bring into this State, certain, 363; bill reported, passed and sent to the senate 386; returned passed and ordered to be engrossed 410.

Bill from the senate, to authorise Josias Hawkins, administrator of Philip A. L. Contee, to bring certain negro, in this State, referred 391; reported favorably upon 427; passed and returned to the senate 438.

Petition of Wm. P. C. Johnson, to be allowed to bring certain negro, into this State, referred 392.

Petition of Wm. M. A. Mister, of Dorchester county, for a law to authorise him to bring certain, in this State, referred 402.

Leave granted to report a bill to make valid the proceedings of J. R. Eccleston, in relation to the introduction of certain, into this State 403; bill reported, passed and sent to the senate 426; returned passed and ordered to be engrossed 503.

Leave granted to report a bill, to authorise Aneus M. Hoffer, to bring into this State, a negro, for life, on certain conditions 436; bill reported, passed and sent to the senate 453; returned passed with amendments, which are assented to, and the bill ordered to be engrossed 533.
